The Violence Stops Here

Did you know?

As a compass card holder you can choose to register or keep your card unregistered

The Compass Card records the time, date, and location of riders at entry and exit of all stations and bus stops

The U-pass is now automatically linked to the Compass Card and therefore is being recorded at all stops and train stations

Transit data gathered by the compass card can be disclosed to law enforcement and regulatory authorities



Registered vs Unregistered Compass Cards

When you choose to register your compass card, you can:

- Load your card online or by calling **604.398.2042**
- Protect your funds, even if your card gets lost or stolen
- Set up automatic top-ups or pass renewals
- Access your travel history online or via phone

- If you feel your card numbers have been compromised, get a new card. The \$6 card fee is refundable, so a new card should cost nothing
- Data is stored for up to 15 months, giving a stalker or abuser the ability to note your routine

How can I keep myself safe with the Compass Card?

What safety and privacy concerns are there regarding the Compass Card?

- Because cards are able to be registered online with no way to confirm identity, keeping compass card numbers safe is a priority
- The compass card records and tracks movement; the information is accessible online or via phone for a registered card
- If you choose to keep your card unregistered, you would have no idea if someone was to get access to the numbers on your compass card and register the card and have access to travel details without the card holder knowing

1. Use cash when that option is available
2. If you have a debit card, buy single fare card and day passes when you are able
3. Keep compass cards in your possession at all times if your card is unregistered
4. Keep online log-in and pin # to yourself and don't share with anyone
5. If you believe your password and/or pin number have been discovered, change them immediately
6. Use multiple cards or share cards with others
