- One in every three women in British Columbia has experienced violence.
- Almost a million women are either assaulted or sexually assaulted in Canada each year.
- In Canada, one in every five women abused by a partner is assaulted during pregnancy.
- More than a million children in Canada have witnessed violence against their mother by their father or father figure.

For women and children who survive **violence**, the consequences can include lasting effects of emotional trauma, injury, or permanent disability.

It's time to **stop** this serious human rights violation. It's time to face up to the fact that violence against women and girls has far-reaching consequences and it **diminishes all of us in society**.

BWSS provides **support and empowerment** to women in abusive intimate relationships, survivors of childhood sexual abuse, and adult sexual assault.

Crisis & Intake Line

Women seeking our services are welcome to call our Crisis & Intake line at 604.687.1867. Our hours are Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday 10am-5pm; Wednesday 10am-8pm. When a woman calls the Crisis & Intake Line. a trained intake worker will provide information, emotional support, and assess her needs and then refer her to the appropriate program or service.





Counselling & Support Groups

Working with a woman's needs, BWSS provides several counselling options including support groups and one-on-one counselling. We offer many types of support groups. These free, facilitated groups give women an opportunity to come together to share experiences in a nurturing and supportive environment. Specialized groups are available including groups for women in same-sex relationships, Spanish-speaking groups and groups for Aboriginal women.



Legal Advocacy

The BWSS legal advocate provides information to women dealing with legal issues such as separation or divorce, child custody, immigration, and more.
